Cartosemyotics and historical maps

The cartography has now reached 8 main conceptual systems. These concepts are based on three major components of cartography as academic science: subject, language and method. The work is presented in the cartography of the already strongly-concepted concept of cartosemyotics in the history of prehistoric times (with primitive maps). According to the materials and research used in the work is based on the so-called Cartosemyotics "pyramid" in relation to time.
